

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CAMPSITE LES ABBERTS

Campers, renters, residential

1° OPENING / CLOSING

The establishment is totally closed from October 30 to April 1. There can be no exceptions to this rule as no one is allowed to enter the premises.

2° AUTOMATIC GATES

The campsite gates are closed from 11pm to 7am.

A car park is at your disposal outside the campsite.

A badge is given to you on arrival, this badge is personal and allows you to enter and leave the campsite. It is imperative that you badge every entrance and exit and that you do not pass behind a car without activating the badge. You must wait for the barrier to close completely before presenting your badge. People who do not respect this operation will be blocked either outside or inside the campsite.

3° THE RECEPTION OFFICE

The reception office is open from April 1 to October 30:

In low season from 10.00 to 12.00 and from 15.00 to 18.00.

In high season from 9:00 to 12:30 and from 15:00 to 20:00

At the reception desk you will find all the information you need about the services of the campsite, the information, the possibilities of supplies, the tourist richness of the surroundings and various addresses that may prove useful.

4° ADMISSION CONDITIONS

In order to be allowed to enter, to settle on the campground, you must have been authorized by the person in charge at the reception desk.

Staying on the campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these regulations and the commitment to comply with them.

Any infringement may lead to the expulsion of the offender and, if necessary, the use of the police.

5° POLICE FORMALITIES

Anyone needing to stay at least one night in the campsite must first present themselves to the person in charge at the reception desk with their identity papers and complete the formalities required by the police.

6° INSTALLATION

The tent, caravan, motor home or any other equipment must be set up on the indicated pitch.

Users must respect the general aesthetics of the campsite, in particular, the plot must not be encumbered by any other installation, or movable property other than the caravan or motor home being used, in accordance with the regulations on outdoor accommodation.

Any vehicle with a double axle is prohibited on the campsite.

Do not install clothes line between the trees, in case of emergency evacuation this represents a real danger.

7° ROYALTIES

Royalties are paid at the reception desk. Their amount is fixed according to the posted tariff, to these fees, the tourist tax is added. They are due according to the number of nights spent on the site.

Camp-site users are invited to inform the reception office of their departure the day before.

Campers intending to leave before the opening time of the reception office must pay their fees the day before.

8° NOISE AND SILENCE

Users of the campsite are urged to avoid any noise and discussions that might disturb their neighbours. Sound equipment must be adjusted accordingly. Door and boot locks should be as unobtrusive as possible.

Silence must be total between 00:00 and 7:00.

9° VISITORS

Visitors may be admitted to the campsite under the responsibility of the receiving campers, who must inform the reception desk in order to pay for their entry into the campsite.

Visitors are not allowed in the aquatic area.

10° CIRCULATION AND PARKING OF VEHICLES

Inside the campsite, vehicles must drive at a speed limited to 10km/h and respect the interior signs.

Traffic is prohibited between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

Users are invited to park in the outside car park and to take the usual precautions to safeguard their vehicles and equipment.

We decline all responsibility in case of theft or burglary.

Only vehicles belonging to campers staying at the campsite are allowed to circulate in the campsite (one vehicle per pitch). Parking must not impede traffic or prevent new arrivals from settling in.

Visitors are required to park their vehicles outside the campsite and report their arrival at the reception desk.

11° RENTAL CONDITIONS

Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite.

It is forbidden to throw polluted water on the ground or in the gutters.

Caravanners and motorhome owners must empty their waste water in the facilities provided for this purpose.

Household waste, rubbish of any kind, papers must be deposited in the bins provided, respecting the selective sorting.

It is forbidden to wash cars inside the campsite.

It is forbidden to take water from fire hydrants and fire hoses, the latter being reserved for this use only to the exclusion of all others.

Plantings and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden for the camper to drive nails into trees, to cut branches, to make plantations. All constructions and improvements are forbidden, except with the express agreement of the operator.

It is also not permitted to delimit the site of an installation by personal means, nor to dig into the ground. In order to allow rainwater to run off on stormy days, digging of the ground around the tents may be authorized by the person in charge.

Any damage to the vegetation, fences, ground or campsite facilities will be at the expense of the person responsible.

12° SÉCURITY

A- FIRE

Open fires, and especially barbecues, (wood, charcoal etc..) are strictly forbidden on the pitches, you will find a place dedicated to barbecues close to a water point. The stoves (electric or gas) must be kept in good working order.

Fire extinguishers are available to all; in case of fire, immediately inform the management and consult the posted safety instructions.

A first-aid kit is available at the reception desk, as well as the numbers of various services.

Cigarette butts must not be thrown away, even when extinguished (ashtrays are available at the reception desk).

The vehicle must be parked in the direction of exit.

B- THEFT

The management is only responsible for objects deposited in the office. Report any suspicious person in the campsite immediately to the manager.

The users of the campsite are invited to take the usual precautions for the safeguard of their material stored on the campsite. The management is not the custodian and guardian of the objects and materials in the campsite.

13° GAMES

No violent or disturbing games may be organised in the vicinity of the facilities. A playground is available for children under the sole responsibility of their parents.

14° CAMPSITE MANAGER

He is responsible for the orderly and orderly running of the campsite. He has the duty to punish serious breaches of the rules and, if necessary, to expel the perpetrators.

15° CARAVANS/MOBILE HOMES

The caravans will have to keep their means of mobility at all times:

- Wheels with pneumatic tyres
- Towing means
- Regulatory braking and signalling device

16° FENCING

It is forbidden to add other boundaries to the fences delimiting the pitches without the authorisation of the management. It is obligatory to leave one side of the pitch open, on the caravan side, in order to be able to take the caravan out of the pitch in an emergency.

17° AQUATIC AREA

The swimming pool is open every day from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm.

The swimming pool is not allowed to visitors.

only swimsuits are allowed, inflatable objects are forbidden.

Balls, beach games and inflatable water buoys are not allowed in the aquatic area.

Access to the aquatic area of the campsite is strictly reserved for customers.

18° ELECTRIC VEHICLES

It is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN** to recharge your vehicle on the campsite, whether on a pitch or in a mobile home.

Any vehicle that does not comply with this ban will be disconnected and the relevant meter cut off.
